The conditions of the above obligation is such that if the above bound *Mary Ann Perrin* shall well, truly, faithfully and impartially administer the goods, chattles and personal estate of *Joseph Perrin* late of the county aforesaid deceased, and do and perform all and every of the duties of Administrator of the state aforesaid agreeably to the laws and usages of the said state of Ohio, then the above obligation shall be void and of none effect, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue
